**Official Meeting Minutes**

DISTRICT MEETING ON; November 02, 2009

Meeting came to order at: 7:00pm.

Jim Coffey reviewed the Water and General Fund Balances and said as always these reports are open to anyone who is interested in viewing them. He spoke with Town Treasurer Bob Sharon about possibly making some accelerated payments to the District as the town had some problems with their MS-5's. These payments would probably start the second week of January. Jim has started the three days of training with the federal software. Steve Eaton, an engineer is helping the District regarding the grants needed for the bridge. The state has reimbursed us the \$4500.00 for the fencing around the wells. Jim also wanted to thank Bob Sharon and Lauralee L'Amonico for all their hard work.

The Hummingbird Bridge grant the District is going for is a 75%-25% split. The government paying the 75%. Jim suggested the ELVD Commissioners contact the Hillsboro Selectmen in early January and ask them for an update on the repair of the Gould Pond Bridge. Jim also suggested this issue be a special warrant article. Commissioner Bob Hutchinson has been going around the District with the surveyor measuring elevation levels. All this information will help us receive grants. The cost will be approximately \$4000.00. Jim suggested we try and set a date for the District's next annual meeting. A suggested time was the second Saturday after the Town of Hillsboro's meeting.

Commissioner Denise DeForest spoke with newly appointed selectmen Rob Buker at the last selectmen's meeting. She said he told her he would like to work with the District without tensions and arguing. Selectmen Joe Collins agreed. The fact that people have to be on the agenda for the town meeting in order to speak was discussed. She said she feels residents and taxpayers should feel comfortable asking questions at these meetings freely, as we do at our District meetings. They agreed with this as well.

The ELVD parking ban is now in effect. No overnight parking from 11:00pm to 7:00pm.

The ELPOA building was sold to a private resident for \$121,000.00. The property does have a water hook up.

Bob Hutchinson and Jim Coffey will be attending local government classes on November 18<sup>th</sup>.

Resident Bob Burton asked if the generators were hooked up yet. Bob said all the boards are in place and Joe D'Amore will be firing up two out of three next week.

PSNH needs to service the feed line on the pump house. They will need a sign off from the town of Hillsboro's building inspector.
