Official Meeting Minutes

DISTRICT MEETING ON; March 05, 2011

Meeting came to order at: 7:10pm.

Moment of Silence

Minutes and Payroll and Payment Manifest accepted as written.

Present; Commissioners Bob Hutchinson and Denise Deforest; District Administrator Jim Coffey; Planning board member and resident Martha Caron.

District Administrator Jim Coffey opened the meeting with his Administrators report.

Bridge update; Jim said the grant for the Hummingbird Bridge needs to be approved by the Governors Council before the District receives it. He said the construction of the bridge would start sometime early summer.

Concerning the dredge permit Jim said DES is requiring the primary source of the problem be solved before the dredging of the inlet can take place. Jim said the engineer who has been working on this issue confirmed the primary problem is the Gould Pond bridge culvert. Jim said the repairing of the Gould Pond Bridge is on the Town of Hillsboro's Warrant this year. He encouraged all Emerald Lake residents to get out and vote on this issue.

Commissioner Bob Hutchinson signed the new lease for the Emerald Lake Village District office on 5 West Main St in Hillsboro.

Bob said the repair of the meeting house well will start in a couple of weeks.

Bob announced DES is offering some workshops on drinking water source protection. He said the fee is \$40.00 for the workshops and all are welcome to attend. The dates are March 24th, 25th, and May 10th from 8:30am to 4:30pm.

Jim discussed the renewal of the Workmen's Compensation Insurance in the District. He gave an example saying if Skip or his son Gary hurt themselves while maintaining the roads we would be covered. Commissioner Denise DeForest made a motion to accept the plan as written. Commissioner Bob Hutchinson seconded.

Jim Coffey and Martha Caron discussed the pros and cons of the Emerald Lake District having their own planning board. Martha wondered if it would be in the best interest of the District to have its own planning board. She said it has taken so long for the town and the District to get along. She said she feels that the District having its own planning board would cause animosity between the two.

Jim said he felt the District residents should have more of a say as to what happens in the District.

Martha questioned whether or not a District can actually have its own planning board; she said she will talk to town planner Shane O'Keefe about the matter.

District Clerk Patricia Stefanelli swore Martha Caron in as Emerald Lake Village District Moderator 2011.
