Commissioners Workshop

On Wednesday March 30th at 7:00pm the Commissioners met with Rick Skarinka from the Department of Environmental Services. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the State Revolving Loan for the Emerald Lake water main project.

Rick started by explaining his position with DES and details about the loan. He stressed that this money is a loan and not a grant. He said the loan comes with a 30% principal forgiveness.

Rick asked the Commissioners and Administrator Jim Coffey to let him know if the District is interested in the loan by the next couple of weeks. Rick was asked if he would help us with the pre-application for the loan and he said he would be with us every step of the way.

The subject of meters came up. Rick asked where we stood on this. Jim Coffey explained the expense involved in the meters. He said it would cost the District an estimated \$600,000 to install meters to each individual house. Rick mentioned data loggers. They are a fraction of the cost and do not have to be installed individually. Rick said he would check to see if these would be acceptable to DES.

The meeting ended at 7:40pm with the Commissioners and Administrator thanking Rick for his time and said they will get back to him regarding the acceptance of the loan.
