Commissioners Workshop**

On Wednesday April 06, 2011 at 7:00pm the Commissioners met with Jenna Rzasa at the ELVD office. Jenna is from Tata and Howard, the engineering firm working with the District on the water main project.

Jenna started the meeting by asking the Commissioners and Jim Coffey where we stand at this point. She said the firm would like a report as to the direction of the project. Bob and Jim explained there are seventeen houses already hooked up to a new system in the Turtle Bridge, Moccasin Trail area.

Jenna reviewed the map outlining the direction of the new piping. She asked about the bids pertaining to the project. Commissioner Bob Hutchinson said they have a couple or three bids but they are a couple of years old. They didn't take any more when they were told the state and federal governments had no money for such projects.

Jenna said the bids will have to be public if we take the loan from DES because it is state funded. She also suggested we hire a soil specialist to test the soil to make sure it isn't aggressive. Aggressive soil will attack the outside of the plastic on the pipes. Commissioner Troy Cornock said the pipes can be wrapped in plastic if the soil is aggressive. He said it's common.

The meeting ended at 7:40 with Jenna reviewing the general direction of the project.
