On Wednesday April 20, 2011 at 7:00pm the Commissioners met with Joe D'Amore and Jenna Rzasa. Joe D'Amore is from Water Systems Operators, who maintain the Districts water system. Jenna Rzasa is from Tata and Howard, the Districts water engineers.

The meeting started with Jenna and Joe discussing the direction of the project as far as the path of the waterlines. Joe said Gould Pond Rd. will probably be the most difficult area as far as the tarred roads go. Administrator Jim Coffey said before the project starts the Commissioners and others involved in the project will meet with the Hillsboro Selectmen and Administrator John Stetser. Jim said alternative school bus routes will have to be discussed and so forth.

Jenna said before anything can start the District must have a survey done. Commissioner Troy Cornock suggested someone he knows. Jenna and Jim also have some surveyors in mind. The surveying job does not have to be bid out but the water project itself does seeing as it's a state funded project. Troy, Jim and Jenna will all get a price from their surveyors and get the best price.

A general discussion followed with all agreeing that it would be a good idea to tie the two bridge projects in with the water line project. It would be favorable to get everything done at once.
