Article 01 To elect officers

To choose one Commissioner for a three-year term; one Clerk for a one-year term; one Treasurer for a one-year term; and one Moderator for a one-year term. (To be voted on by Official Ballot.)

Article 02 To borrow funds for well treatment

To see if the Village District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$700,000 (gross budget) for the purpose of developing/ installing an arsenic treatment system and building necessary to support the hummingbird well site facility, and authorize the District Commissioners to: (a) Issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and determine the rate of interest thereon from the NH State Revolving Loan Fund in an amount not more than \$385,000 in accordance with the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) from the NH State Revolving Loan Fund; and (b) Accept and expend one or more grants from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Fund in the amount of \$140,000 and \$175,000 from the Groundwater Trust Fund. The Board of Commissioners recommends this article. (3/5 ballot vote required.)
